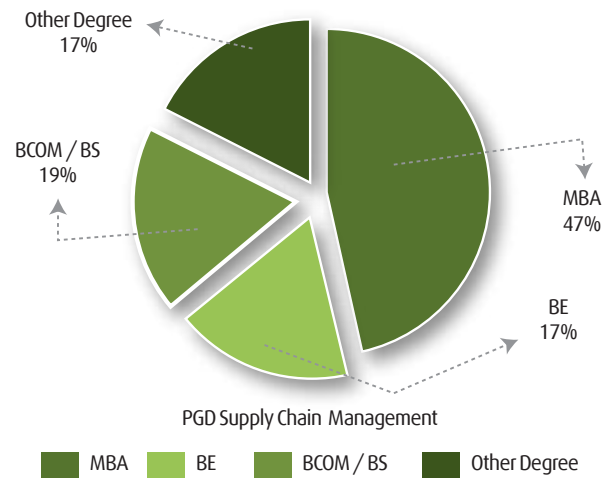
Applicant must have a bachelor's degree from HEC recognized educational institution in any area of study (or particularly in SCM/ HRM & PM) and:

- Preliminary Interviews & Test will be conducted to shortlist the candidates

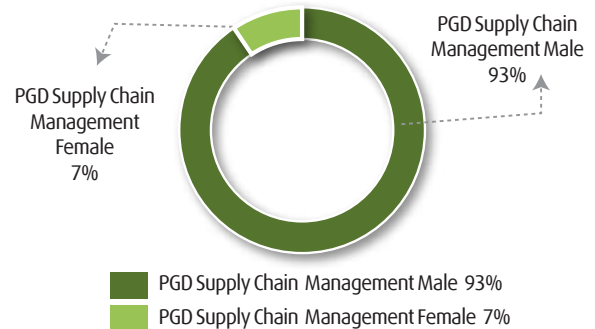

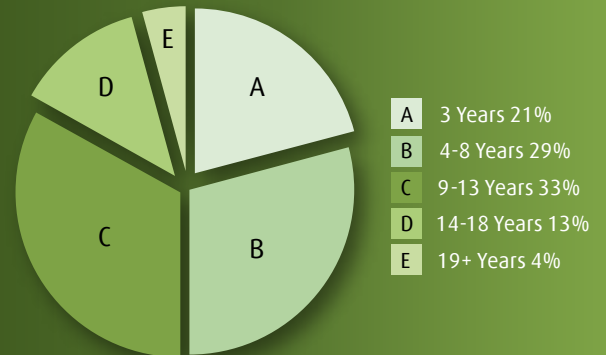
