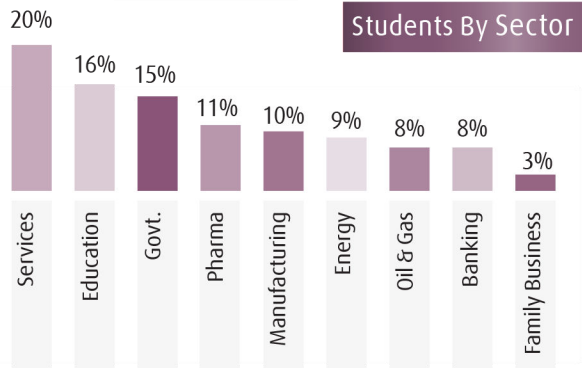

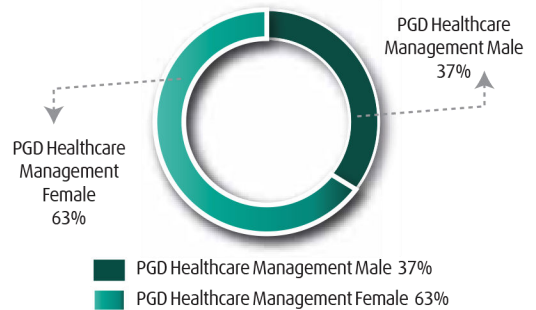

Students by Qualification



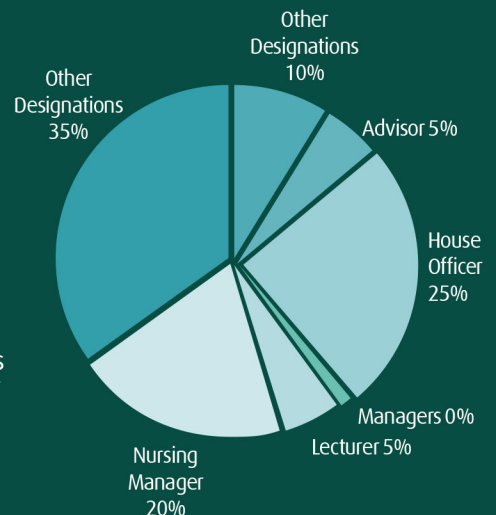
