Overview

The dawn of 21st century coincided with the Enron scandal, and produced far reaching ripples in the commercial arena. The listed companies and public sector companies are subject to Corporate Governance oversight; and not-for-profit institutions will soon follow. Directors of listed companies and public sector companies are required to secure formal certification in the form of Directors' Training Program (DTP).
