




Directors' Training Program

Program Overview

The Centre for Executive Education (CEE) at IBA designs and delivers exclusive corporate governance and leadership development programs. The Directors' Training Program (DTP) is a flagship initiative tailored to meet the needs of board members and directors across corporate governance sectors. The program enhances board leadership capabilities and strengthens the ability of directors to operate effectively in an increasingly complex business environment.

Directors of listed companies and public sector organizations are required to obtain formal certification through a Directors' Training Program. The DTP offered by CEE at IBA is approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) and recognized by the Chartered Management Institute (CMI), UK.

This five-day intensive training program provides guidance across key governance areas to help directors meet regulatory requirements and remain updated with evolving governance frameworks. Participants gain in-depth knowledge of corporate governance principles, best practices, and practical tools that support effective governance implementation.

Strong corporate governance enables organizations to improve performance, enhance access to financing, and ensure sustainable growth. The program addresses the unique governance challenges faced by businesses and introduces structures and practices that help mitigate risks and strengthen organizational viability. Moving beyond theoretical concepts, the program offers concise and practical governance tools that participants can directly apply in their professional roles. The program consists of two comprehensive modules, covering essential regulatory knowledge and broader subject matter awareness expected of directors of listed companies, incorporating both local and global best practices.


