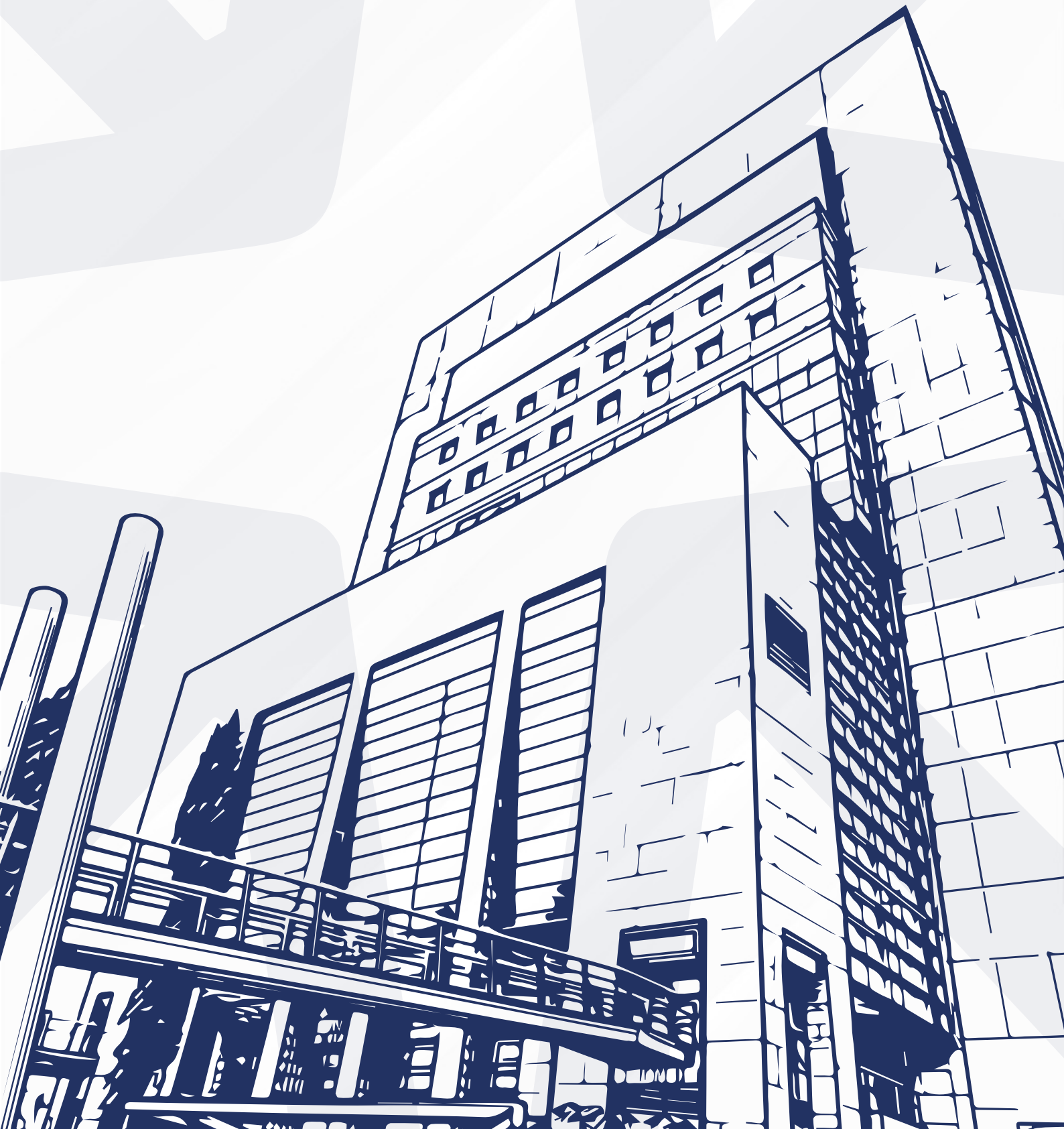


Train the Trainer
